Parents of the Rose Queen and retinue are invited to attend the committee meetings to plan Rose Queen Day and other events (next meeting AGM Tuesday 19th April 2022, 7.30pm, Whitley Village Hall).

The new Rose Queen & her Retinue will each be given a financial contribution towards their outfits and flowers for Rose Queen day. Rose Queen £90, Chief Attendant and Small Attendants £65, Crown Bearer £45 and Train Bearers £40. We do not wish to exclude anyone due to financial constraints and the Committee will look at any individual cases confidentially and discretely. With sustainability in mind, parents of the chosen retinue are encouraged to be considered in their outfit purchases which can be kept simple.

The Queens' cloaks are provided and alternate each year between red & blue to distinguish between the new Queen and the retiring Queen and their respective Retinues. This year's new Queen will have the blue cloak.

The parent/guardian of the elected Rose Queen will be given the contact details for the parent/guardian of each member of the elected Retinue. It is then their responsibility to organise meetings with the other families to make the necessary arrangements for outfits and flowers. It is expected that the families of the Rose Queen and Retinue will collaborate and coordinate the choosing and buying of the children's outfits. As the eldest child, the Rose Queen generally has the final say in the selection of outfits but this should not be without consultation with the other families.

On Rose Queen Day it has become common for members of the Retinues to exchange small gifts <u>however</u>; this is left entirely to the discretion of all the parents. Just the Rose Queen Committee gift will be officially presented to the Queen on stage.
