**Cheshire West and Chester Council SEND specific HAF sessions are as detailed in the booklet. Sessions will take place during the school summer holidays, all sessions are free for \*eligible children and young people attending, for siblings attending that don't have SEND then charges may apply, parents/carers will not be charged to attend or support their child at any session.**

**All sessions will come with the provision of a healthy food option as part of the HAF offer, which could consist of either hot or cold food dependent on the session and location of delivery.**

**\*To be eligible to access free HAF provision a child/young person must have an identified special educational need and or disability**
